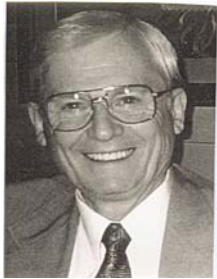


Message from the President

New Testament Survey II (3 Credits):

This class is a survey of the New Testament books from Acts – Revelation, including their historical background; authorship; date written; the purpose of each book; as well as how they became a part of the New Testament. We will see that the New Testament is God's final revelation to man and how it presents the fulfillments of all Old Testament prophecy. New Testament I is not a prerequisite for this class.
